The Year That Was



The third edition of the ISB Insights Forum was held at the Mohali campus, bringing together leaders from academia, industry, government, and philanthropy to shape actionable research agendas on critical national and global challenges. On the occasion, the ISB Research Catalyst Award was presented to Azim Premji, Founder Chairman of Wipro, recognising his outstanding contributions to strengthening India's research ecosystem.

The Forum was headlined by sessions led by Karthik Muralidharan, Tata Chancellor's Professor of Economics, University of California, San Diego, and Shivkumar Kalyanaraman, CEO, Anusandhan National Research Foundation. It featured discussions on themes such as the future of assets and NFTs, data science and digital technology in healthcare administration, wealth creation through capital markets, and climate impacts, climate action, and climate justice.



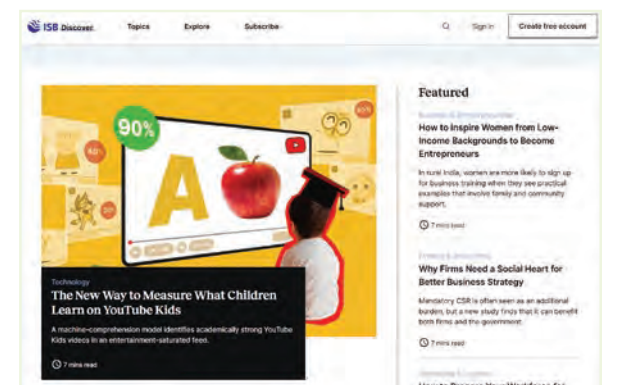
PGP YL

The School welcomed the founding cohort of 130 students to the 20-month Post Graduate Programme in Management for Young Leaders (PGP YL). The cohort has an average age of 23, with 50% of them being women and 68% having full-time experience. The class demonstrates academic excellence with strong average test scores (CAT: 99.1 percentile, GMAT: 731, GRE: 327), and diverse backgrounds. Over 40% of the class has received scholarships, including full and partial waivers of tuition and commitment fees, reflecting strong support from the industry for the programme.

Motilal Oswal Executive Centre Inaugurated at ISB Following ₹100 Crore Gift

The School inaugurated the Motilal Oswal Executive Centre at the Hyderabad campus, a state-of-the-art 1.91 lakh sq. ft. facility enabled by a very generous ₹100 crore philanthropic contribution from the Motilal Oswal Foundation, the charitable arm of Motilal Oswal Financial Services.

The Executive Centre was inaugurated by Sri Bhatti Vikramarka Mallu, Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister (Finance, Planning and Energy), Government of Telangana, in the presence of



Motilal Oswal, Managing Director and CEO, Motilal Oswal Financial Services Ltd. and Chairman, Motilal Oswal Foundation; members of ISB's Executive Board including Pramath Raj Sinha (Founding Dean, ISB), Nitin Paranjpe (Non-Executive Chairman, Hindustan Unilever), and Dean Madan Pillutla.

The Centre houses lecture theatres, meeting rooms, a townhall, and office spaces designed to foster executive education, leadership summits, and industry dialogues. By expanding ISB's capacity to deliver high-impact leadership programmes, it strengthens the School's mission of equipping professionals to lead in an ever-evolving business landscape.



Taparia Family Establishes Multi-Year Scholarships for 50 PGP and PGP YL Students

Mahavir Prasad Taparia, Managing Director, Supreme Industries Limited; and Shivratna Taparia, Executive Director, Supreme Industries Limited, have established the Taparia Family Scholarships at ISB. Beginning with the PGP Class of 2026 and the PGP YL (Founding) Class of 2027, these scholarships will support five students each from the next five classes of these programmes by offering them a 100% tuition fee waiver - benefitting 50 students altogether. This multi-year commitment by the Taparia family marks a significant contribution to ISB's scholarships programme, helping more deserving students access a transformative education and unlocking opportunities for future leaders.



J.C. Flowers ARC Institutes Multi-Year Scholarships for PGP and PGP YL

The J.C. Flowers ARC Scholarships are supported by a three-year scholarship commitment from J.C. Flowers Asset Reconstruction Private Limited (JCF ARC) that will benefit 30 students across the Post Graduate Programme in Management (PGP) and the Post Graduate Programme in Management for Young Leaders (PGP YL). The scholarships commenced in the current academic year through a CSR gift, with similar commitments planned for the next two years. Under these scholarships, 100% tuition fee waivers will be awarded to five students each from the PGP and PGP YL every year.

Adani Group Supports Six PGP YL Scholarships as part of their AALP

The Adani Group, through one of its group companies, has committed to supporting full tuition fee waivers for six students of the inaugural PGP YL class – as a part of the Adani Accelerated Leadership Program (AALP).



Kanoria Foundation Commits Five-Year Scholarship Support for PGP YL

ISB has received a commitment from the Kanoria Foundation to establish the Kanoria Foundation Scholarship for the Post Graduate Programme in Management for Young Leaders (PGP YL). The five-year commitment will support 10 students, designated as Kanoria Foundation Scholars, with 100% tuition fee waivers awarded to two students annually, beginning July 2026. The scholarship is designed to expand access to ISB's early-entry management programme by enabling high-potential young leaders to pursue the PGP YL irrespective of financial background.

DSP Asset Managers Institutes Multi-Year Scholarship Programme for PGP YL

The DSP Scholarship Programme, supported by a multi-year CSR commitment from DSP Asset Managers Private Limited, has been instituted for the Post Graduate Programme in Management for Young Leaders (PGP YL) at ISB. Designed as a need-cum-merit scholarship, the initiative provides 100% tuition fee waivers to selected students over multiple years, beginning with the current academic cycle. Under this programme, two students from the founding PGP YL class will be supported, with the scholarship extending to five students annually in subsequent years.

Bharti Airtel Foundation Institutes Five Need-Cum-Merit Scholarships for PGP YL Students

Bharti Airtel Foundation has committed to a multi-year support for PGP YL scholarships, by offering a full waiver on tuition, accommodation, and meal expenses to five students from every class of the programme - through a structured need-cum-merit scholarship. This support reflects the Foundation's focus on expanding access to quality education for high-potential students from diverse backgrounds.





Mphasis Makes Multi-Year Grant to Support AI Research Through the Mphasis AI Hub at ISB

Mphasis has launched the Mphasis AI Hub at ISB – a cross-functional collaboration aimed at accelerating AI-led research, innovation, and capacity building for societal and sectoral impact in India, supported by a multi-year CSR grant from the Mphasis F1 Foundation.

The initiative will focus initially on Healthcare and Finance, with plans to expand into other priority sectors. At the core of the partnership is the establishment of a dedicated AI Research

Hub at ISB, designed to serve as a platform for interdisciplinary research and multi-stakeholder collaboration. The initiative aims to advance responsible AI innovation by driving research that addresses real-world challenges; enabling the responsible adoption, evaluation, and impact assessment of AI solutions in live environments; strengthening digital literacy and institutional capacity among relevant stakeholders; and fostering wider knowledge-sharing through repositories, partnerships, and annual convenings.

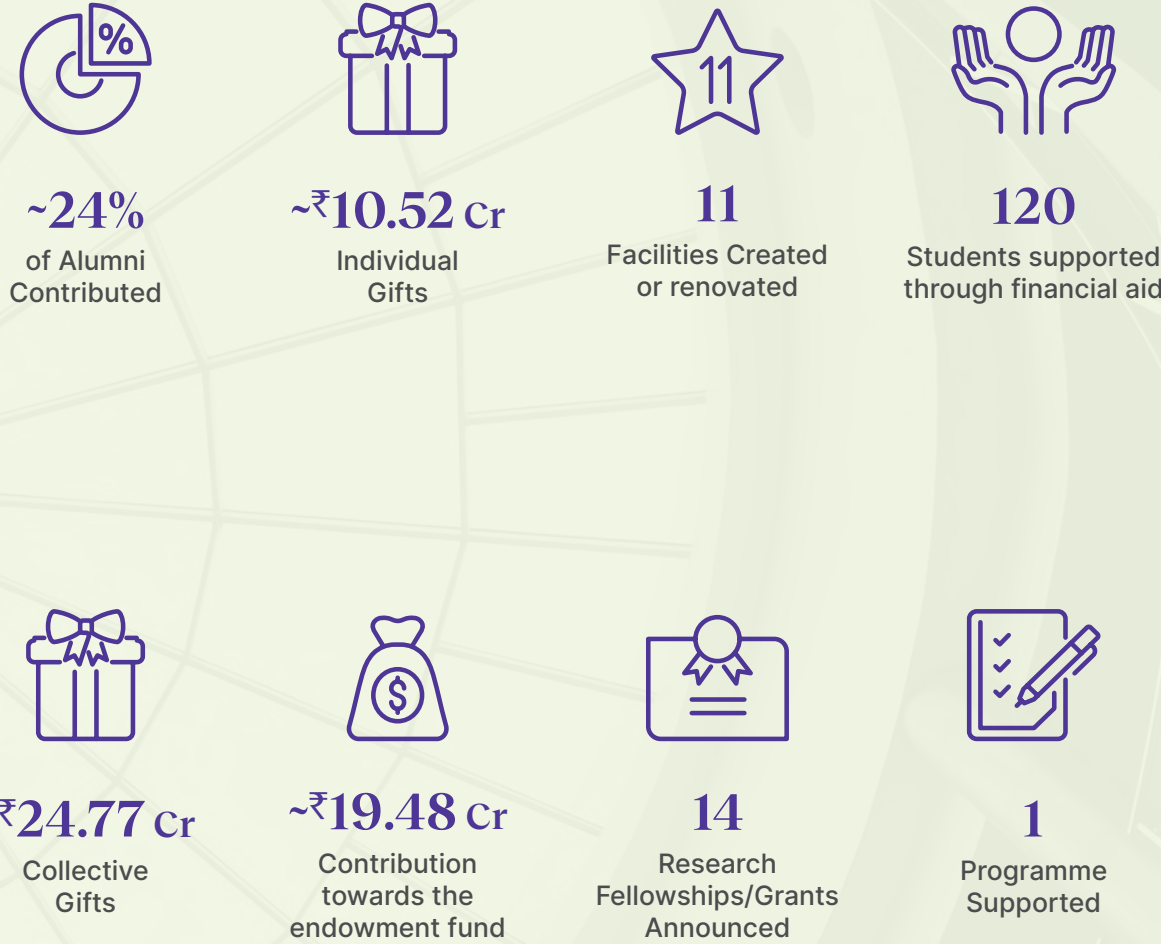
